Severe Weather and Snow Policy

During inclement weather please listen to the media stations listed below. If a storm arrives during the day and it is necessary for an early dismissal, we will contact you at your listed telephone number. If we cannot reach you, we will contact the persons designated by you on your child's Emergency Contact Form. Please make arrangements prior to such an event to have someone that is available to pick up your child in the case of an early dismissal.

A closing will not be called due to cold temperatures, but only when the roads are unsafe for travel due to snow or ice. The policy is as follows:

- Our program follows the Pittsburgh Public School closure and delay schedule. Due to staffing limitations we do not offer care on any additional days.
- In the case of a 2 hour delay we will provide direct van transportation to John Morrow Elementary, Propel Northside and Allegheny Traditional Academy. Students attending other schools must have bus transportation arranged with the exact time they should be at the bus stop.
